

Forklift Safety

Forklifts move quickly and can pose a hazard to those operating or working around them. Be mindful of your surroundings, and remember these safety tips.

When working around a forklift:

- □ Pay attention, and stay clear when a forklift is in motion.
- □ Work in designated pedestrian areas only.
- □ Avoid taking shortcuts through traffic areas.
- □ Let the forklift operator know when you are working in the area.
- □ Never engage in horseplay around a forklift.
- □ Do not help move unstable loads; if the load falls, you could be seriously injured.
- □ Do not get too close to an operating forklift; you could get caught between it or under it.

When operating a forklift:

- □ You and your employer are responsible for the safe and proper use of the equipment.
- □ Read the manufacturer's instructions before operating or performing maintenance on the equipment.
- □ Ensure the audio and visual backup signals are working properly.
- □ Wear a seat belt.
- □ Inspect the tires and brakes before each use.
- $\hfill \square$ Always be aware of the forklift's capacity, and NEVER exceed the limit.

- 2. Why should people be kept away from moving forklifts?
- 3. Is it safe to exceed the maximum weight of a forklift when moving materials?
- 4. Why should the load be stable before moving?
- 5. Why is it dangerous to engage in horseplay around a forklift?

Forklift Safety

Be Safe! Follow these rules:

- 1. The operator should be the only person on the forklift. Move materials, not people.
- 2. Be aware of your surroundings. Listen for horns, and look for flashing lights.
- 3. Never walk under an elevated load.
- 4. Be careful! Do not trip over the forks when a forklift is lowered.
- 5. Use the forklift to lift material, not people.
- 6. Stay in designated walkways. Let the forklift operator know when you are working in the area.
- 7. Do not walk too close to an operating forklift; you could get caught between it or under it.
